THE OPERATION OF THE ACT

SOUTH AUSTRALIA } *Proclamation by His Excellency the*
to wit } *Governor of the State of South Australia*

(L.S.) M. L. OLIPHANT

BY virtue of the provisions of the Mining Act, 1971-1972, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby reserve the lands defined in the schedule hereto from the operation of Parts IV, V, VI, VII and VIII of the said Act.

THE SCHEDULE

A. All those portions of the State of South Australia, including Kangaroo Island, situate within 800 metres inland from high water mark along the respective sea coasts.

B. All those portions of the State of South Australia, including Kangaroo Island, situate between low water mark and high water mark along the respective sea coasts.
